“Capture the Day” for ‘everyday’ photographers:

This contest will be for digital photos taken during that day at Lake Fannin. Entries will be in one of three categories: Best *Wildlife* Shot (critters or plants), Best *People* Shot, Best *Landscape*.

We will have a computer and printer there to print the entries. Judging – people’s choice – will take place in the late afternoon at the Lake Fannin Lodge. A cash prize for each category will be distributed from the extra \$5 cost for the Photography Package (Pkg C). In addition, an overall ‘grand’ prize – a framed enlargement of the winning photo – will be awarded for the photo receiving the most votes. (Framed size will depend on the resolution of the original photo).

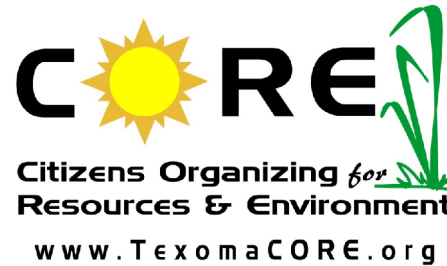
Hit the Trail: Focus on Fannin
