**Birch Creek Farms** is located near Wapanucka in scenic western Atoka County, Oklahoma — along the Clear Boggy River and Birch Creek. The rich, fertile, sandy loam soils deposited by these two drainages provide the ideal environment for fruit and vegetable production. We utilize "sustainable agriculture" practices to produce the highest quality, farm-fresh produce available. Our farm consists of approximately 700 diverse acres, both leased and owned, that have been in our family for four generations. At Birch Creek Farms, we grow a wide variety of vegetables, fruits, herbs, and grass-fed beef. Many of these fruits and vegetable varieties were grown on the farm by our earlier generations.

## **Fresh Fruits and Vegetables:**

Leafy greens, such as spinach, lettuce, Swiss chard, arugula, collards, turnip greens, and mustard greens. Other early vegetables include onions, new potatoes, turnips, radishes, carrots, peas, and beets. Summer crops include yellow squash, zucchini, okra, cucumbers, eggplant, tomatoes (heirloom, beefsteak, and grape varieties), several varieties of bell peppers and hot peppers, okra, sweet corn, green beans, purple hull peas and cream crowder peas, green beans, pecans, summer and winter squash, watermelon, cantaloupe, honeydew melon, and pumpkins.

During the Autumn Harvest we offer a pumpkin patch, maze, hay ride, petting zoo, a bounce house, and other exciting activities for the kids to enjoy. Pumpkins are available pre-picked or in our u-pick pumpkin patch. We also offer many other fall ornamentals such as gourds, Indian corn, corn stalks, straw bales, and mums.
